AREA OF COOPERATION

- 1. Developing policy reform to reduce illegal logging and associated trade in illegally logged timber**
- 2. Developing system and verification of legal compliance**
- 3. Exchange data and information in timber trade and wood products**
- 4. Collaboration on enforcement agencies and networking**
- 5. Capacity building and human resource development**
- 6. Involvement of civil society in combating illegal logging**
- 7. Promoting adaptive forest practice toward SFM**

INDONESIA-CHINA

- **Very slow and poor progress**
- **Exchange data and information**
 - A vessel carrying illegal timber was informed to Indonesia**
- **No special taskforce established**

INDONESIA - JAPAN

- 1. Task force has been established**
- 2. Intensive discussion to follow up the MoU**
- 3. Detailed action plan has been set up**
- 4. Project starts 2005**

INDONESIA - UK

- 1. Task force internal MoF has been established**
- 2. Activities carried out under DFID projects in Indonesia**
- 3. Program and activities will be incorporated in the EU project, starts 2005**
- 4. ILRC is on going project focused in 3 NP (Tg. Putting, Gn. Palung, BBS)**
